Banchory Bangle Colouring Competition 2024 for charity Children First.

The Banchory Bangle is an exquisite piece of hand engraved jewellery created by Malcolm Appleby at his home and workshop in Grandtully, Highland Perthshire. The first bangle from which its name derives was made 47 years ago in Banchory, near Malcolm's then home at Crathes Station.

The project has evolved over the decades with continued support of **The Deeside Committee** and long term connection **Taylor's On The High Street** where prize bangles are on display and raffle tickets are for sale. Each year the design is inspired by nature and this year's design depicted here for this colouring sheet is **Hedgehog**. Set amidst a background of hawthorn, wild rose, leaves, berries, hazelnuts and flowers alongside a willow warbler, hedge sparrow, ladybirds, wood mice, a ground beetle, a comma butterfly and a red squirrel.
